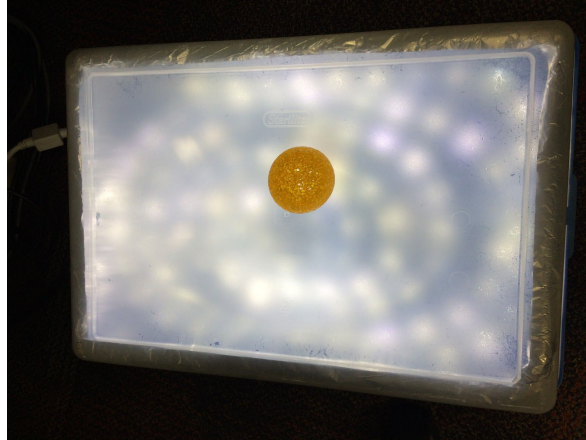


Do-It-Yourself Lightbox



Materials:

- 16-foot LED rope light - Amazon or Walmart (Lowes/Home Depot) ~\$16
- 28 quart clear plastic tote (23 x 16 ¼ x 6") - Walmart ~\$8-\$10
- Vellum paper (white) - Walmart (pack of 10) ~\$4
 - **OR** glass frosting spray, which was used for this light box
- Tin foil
- Hot glue gun and glue

Instructions:

- 1) Purchase supplies (~\$35)
- 2) Cut out small hole in side/corner of tote lid (to put rope light plug through - see below)



- 3) Use hot glue or spray glue to attach tin foil around inside (sides) of tote (see below)



- 4) Wrap rope light inside bottom of tote lid with hot glue every 5-6 inches (see below)



- 5) Tape or glue down vellum paper inside OR spray bottom of tote with glass frosting spray 2-3 times to only let light through
- 6) Turn off lights and plug light box in!
 - a) May need extension cord for added distance



***Optional Sizes**

Large: 16' rope light and 28 quart plastic tote

Medium: 12' rope light and 15 quart plastic tote

Small: 6' rope light and 12 quart plastic tote
